

# **Position Posting for RTC Services**

## **Full Time Mechanic**

RTC Services is looking for an experienced mechanic to lead our vehicle maintenance department. This position is responsible for maintaining public transit vehicles ranging from mini vans to 13 passenger buses. This is a full time position – 40 hours per week, health/dental/vision benefits, IRA, vacation time, and holiday pay. Starting wage is \$14.00 per hour.

This position is a safety-sensitive position requiring the inspection and maintenance of all vehicles and equipment on a regular basis to ensure the safe and lawful operation of the system fleet. Performance of these duties must be conducted in compliance with all applicable DOT, federal, state, local, and system regulations and policies, including U.S. DOT drug and alcohol testing regulations. This position is also responsible for performing routine inspections of facility and equipment to assure proper maintenance of facility and equipment in conjunction with maintenance plans. Supervises vehicle detailing and building janitorial staff. Serves as back-up driver in order to facilitate timely pick-up and drop-off of passengers.

- High School diploma or equivalent.
- Valid Ohio Driver's License.
- Meet or exceed system-established driver eligibility standards including background checks, physicals, and drug testing.
- Must have a minimum of 3 years vehicle maintenance experience or educational equivalent.
- Must possess and maintain a good driving record meeting or exceed system's established driver eligibility standards. Driver's abstract will be requested annually.
- Prefer experience working with individuals with disabilities.
- Requires First Aid and CPR certification. (Can be done after hire)
