OPTIONS

1. **Transportation for Logan County**: Provides general public transportation. All vehicles are wheel chair accessible. The cost of trips vary with the distance traveled. Some trips may be provided at a discount or at no cost through specialized programs for those who qualify. **(937)593-0039**
2. **RTC**: Provides transportation to and from work in Logan County for persons with disabilities. Transportation is also available to assist in preparing for, obtaining and maintaining employment. **(937)592-0534**
3. **Superior Delivery & Transit**: Specializes in non-emergency medical transport and more. **(937)935-1267**
4. **Robinaugh EMS**: An emergency medical service and patient transportation service. They offer basic & advanced life support ambulance service in addition to wheelchair transportation and are Passport providers. **(937)599-2340**.
5. **Integrity Ambulance Service**: Transport patients on an emergency and non-emergency basis throughout the state of Ohio. **(800)704-7846**
6. **Clymer Medical Transport**: Transports patients on a non-emergency basis within 7 counties including Logan. **(419)222-3786**
